Thursday 27th November –

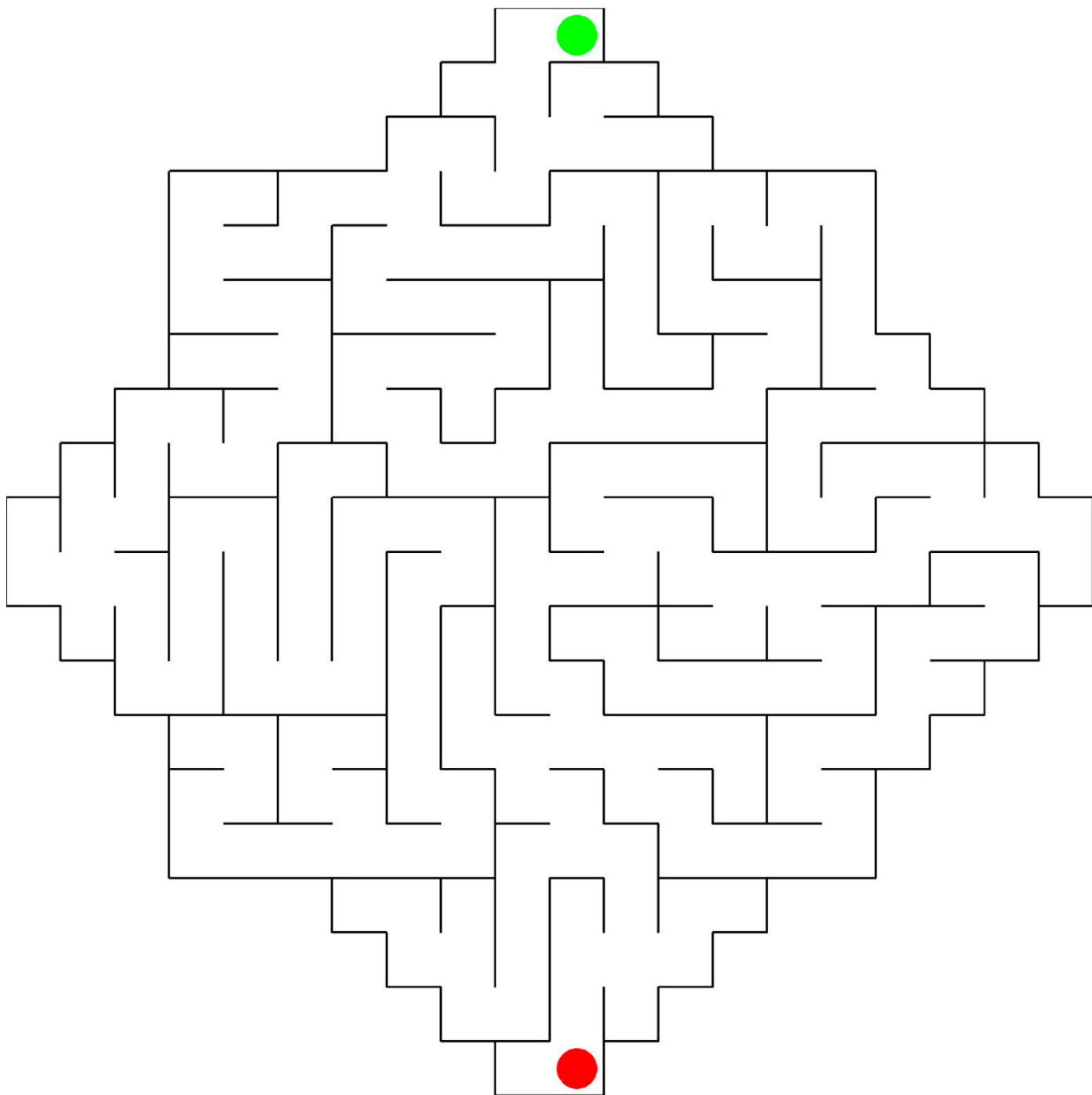
Trip to Perry woods garden centre being picked up at 10:45am (time may change but I will let you all know asap) by Tim from Go start.
